When is the first day of school?

The first day for Grade 6 is Wednesday September 5, 2017 at 7:45. This day will be only the 480 grade 6 students. Our staff will be ready to welcome our students on the morning of September 5th. We will be outside helping with the movement of cars and pedestrians. We ask that you bear with us as we expect unanticipated obstacles here and there. We thank you in advance for your understanding and patience.

The first day for Grade 7 and 9 is Thursday September 6, 2017 at 7:45 am.

6th graders will meet in the gym at 7:45 on Wednesday – Enter through the A2 doors on Brookline Street
7th graders will meet in the cafeteria at 7:45 on Thursday - Enter through the A2 doors on Brookline Street
8th graders will meet in the gym at 7:45 - Enter through the A2 doors on Brookline Street

And, the first week?

School will resume to its normal routines for the rest of the week. This means that breakfast, morning gym, after school clubs, and transportation will run at their regularly scheduled times: 7:15 to 7:45 and 2:45 to 3:45.

What about drop off and pick up?

Brookline Street is a One Way from Chatham Street towards Empire Street two times a day on school days:

7:15 to 8:15 am

2:00 to 3:00 pm

There is no parking or idling in front of the school. This space is reserved for Lynn Public Schools transportation. Please respect the orange cones. See the flow chart below.

Parking?

When visiting the school, from 8:15 am to 2:00 pm, you may park in the parking lot to the left of the gym or on the street. However, **during drop off and pick up times parking in the parking lot is prohibited to ensure school safety.**

What about our new neighbors?

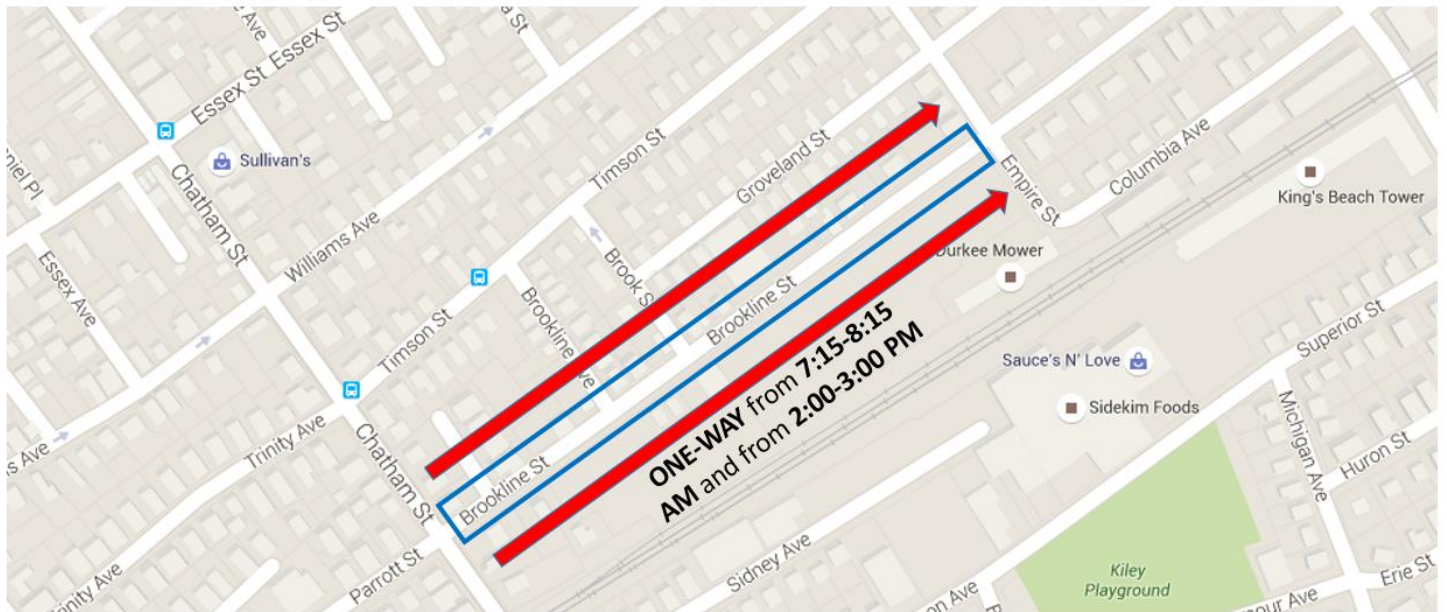
